



Covid has affected so many aspects of business

- 1. Logistics affected Chinese ports because cannot get workers; increased costs
- 2. Supply chains workers in the Chinese factories; increased costs
- 3. Business travel to China preventing in-person meetings increased reports of IP theft, "fraying" of relationships between US China teams particularly for companies with new leadership
- 4. Difficulty of terminating, hiring & training employees in China particularly senior level
- 5. Evaluating of global supply chain forcing diversification "make where you sell"
- 6. Evaluating of global manufacturing footprint


